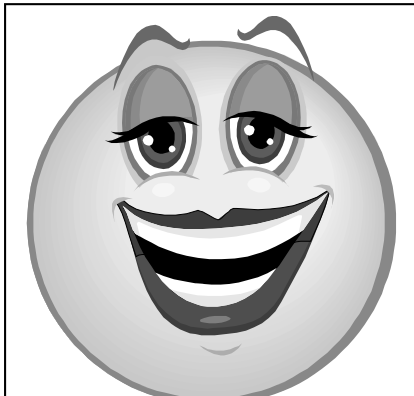


MCA Auction Advice Column
