New Concepts

It is hard to believe, but we are ready to take off with new things.

- **We have been working on two vowels.** There are two rules for marking vowels. Words with one vowel get a smile over the vowel (short vowel sign). When there are two vowels, the first vowel gets a line over it. The second vowel gets a slash through it because it is silent.
- **We are learning special sounds.** These are letters that occasionally break the rules for their sound or combinations of letters. You will see them listed on future calendars and in the newsletters. We do special days such as **fleece** and **flannel** day and **slipper** day. This week we learned ay in pray, o in go, e in me, ck in duck, st in stop, and y in fly. Next week we will be learning fl in flake, sl in sleep, gl in glass, pl in plane, cl in clock, gl in glue, and bl in block.
- We will be working on numbers adding up to five. We will be working on dimes, nickels, and pennies and their value. We will be working on number words one to four.
